I refer to your official information request received on 1 May 2024 where you asked:

"Please provide a list of those bodies that fall under the Fees framework. i.e Those bodies whose members have their fees set according to the framework. If you do not have this list please advise who does or forward this request to them."

## **Our response**

Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission (the Commission) does not hold a list of the bodies that fall under the Cabinet Fees Framework (the Framework).

Therefore, we are refusing your request under section 18(g) of the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) on the grounds the information requested is not held by the Commission and we do not believe the information is held in its entirety, by any other government agency.

## Other information

Although there is no full list of bodies that fall under the Framework, the *Cabinet Office Circular CO (22) 2: Revised Fees Framework for members appointed to bodies in which the Crown has an interest* has a summary, on page nine, of the bodies covered and not covered by the Framework.
