I refer to your official information request received on 9 October 2024 for:

- 1. The number of directly employed staff currently working at the Public Service Commission.
- 2. The number of directly employed staff and their positions who earn less than \$27.80 per hour (excluding all allowances or overtime rates).

Our response

Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission (the Commission) publishes workforce data and contractor and consultant expenditure data quarterly on our website. The most recent workforce data and contractor and consultant expenditure data release is the annual data set as at 30 June 2024. This data was released on 10 October 2024 and can now be found here: <u>Workforce Data -</u> <u>Workforce size - Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission</u>. On this page, you are able to filter data by agency and make comparisons of data year on year.

As at 14 October 2024, the number of directly employed staff currently working at Te Kawa Mataaho Public Service Commission was 173. No employees of the Commission earn less than \$27.80 per hour. On that basis, I am refusing this part of your request under section 18(e) of the OIA on the grounds the information requested does not exist.
