There are no documents containing decisions about reinforcing the standards of integrity and conduct of public servants. I am therefore refusing this part of your request under section 18(g) of the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) on the grounds the information does not exist.

In making my decision, I have considered the public interest considerations in section 9(1) of the OIA.
